

## **English Information (CSUS)**

### **English Composition**

An additional English composition course is required for graduation. SCC's English 301 or 302 **can be used** to satisfy GE and the graduation requirements **for students whose catalog year is Fall 1992 or later**.

**ERROR:** On some of the old forms, it states that it **cannot** be used for both. As long as the student's catalog year is Fall 1992 or later, it can satisfy both requirements.

### **English 2 at CSUS**

#### **At SCC:**

Students attending SCC after completing English 2 at CSUS **HAVE NOT** met the prerequisite requirements for ENGWR 300, 301, or 302. Students are required to take SCC's English assessment test to determine appropriate placement.

#### **At CSUS:**

Effective 2009-10, English 2 is considered equivalent to English 1A. Therefore, English 2 will also fulfill prerequisites for other courses, just like English 1A.

English 2 will be added to 2009-10 articulation agreements as an option for English 1A.
