Significant updates to majors are summarized below.

**Cognitive Sciences, B.S.:**

For the first time, the Cognitive Sciences major will be open to transfer students starting Fall 2022. This major will participate in TAG. Please read general information sections carefully. This major will have new requirements starting in Fall 2023. I would like to strengthen our articulation agreements for this major, so I will be sending out a separate email to solicit for the following courses: BIO SCI 35, BIO SCI 36, BIO SCI 37, BIO SCI 38, LSCI 3, LSCI 10, LSCI 20, LSCI 51, LPS 30.

**Game Design & Interactive Media, B.S.:**

Starting in Fall 2022 admissions, we will no longer require two semesters of Calculus. The only admissions requirement to this major will be one year of computer programming courses. Some new courses have also been added to the curriculum: GDIM 25, GDIM 27, GDIM 31, GDIM 32, GDIM 33, GDIM 41, GDIM 51, GDIM 53, GDIM 55, GDIM 61. I will be sending out a separate email to solicit for course outlines.

**Nursing Science, B.S.:**

This major will have one new requirement for Fall 2023 – a foundational biology class equivalent to BIO SCI 93. Biochemistry and Organic Chemistry will no longer be required. New course added to curriculum: NUR SCI 50; I will be sending out a separate email to solicit for course outlines.

**Psychology, B.A.:**

Fall 2022 admissions will be the last year that students can apply to the Psychology, B.A. major. In the future, we recommend that any students interested in the Psychology, B.A. major apply to the Psychological Science, B.A. in the School of Social Ecology. Those interested in the study of psychology should be aware that we also have a Psychology, B.S. major and a Cognitive Sciences, B.S. major offered by the School of Social Sciences and a Neurobiology, B.S. major offered by the School of Biological Sciences.
