

Issue/Concern Bicycle Thefts

A. Describe the issue/concern:

There has been an ongoing issue of bicycle thefts on campus. This semester there have been two thefts; last year, there had been over twenty-five thefts from the college. Bicycle racks lack sufficient security measures to prevent thefts. The issue had been brought to the student council, and nothing was done. Furthermore, the college has known about this issue for years and has been negligent in putting forth a solution.

B. What do you recommend or suggest solving this issue/concern?

A bike cage needs to be put into place that will be monitored and have extra security measures to ensure the safety of the student's belongings while they attend class. Additional security measures would include but not limited to constant surveillance of cameras, a security guard monitoring those who go in and out, and a form of key access to gain entry into the cage. I have identified three potential locations on campus for the enclosure to be installed as well as the estimated cost based on a previous work order.

C. How will this recommendation support the success of SCC students and benefit the campus community?

First, by putting a bike cage on campus, students would have peace of mind and be able to focus on their classes. Second, students would also be less reliant on public transportation that can be late. Lastly, there would be fewer students driving to campus and thus decreasing the number of vehicles reducing overflow and emissions.
